WORKING WITH LGBTQ+ COMMUNITIES

An introductory interactive workshop to introduce language, issues, and experiences related to the LGBTQ+ community, as well as basic concepts of allyship and inclusive practices. This is the primer workshop to prepare for level 2 trainings. (2 hours)

TRANS & GENDER DIVERSITY

This workshop is a follow-up to Working with LGBTQ+ Communities and offers more indepth information and practice opportunities related to understanding and affirming gender identity. In this participatory workshop, attendees will learn more about gender, the array of gender identities, and how to create safer and inclusive spaces. (2 hours)

INTERSECTIONS OF IDENTITY

This workshop provides participants with language and frameworks for understanding the ways our identities (race, class, gender, sexuality, ability) intersect with one another are impacted by bias, privilege, and other structures within society. Using reflection, activities, and thoughtful dialogue, participants will learn how identity influences us and our interpretation of the world. (2 hours)

CREATING EQUITY THROUGH AFFIRMING GENDER IDENTITIES

During this workshop, participants will gain an understanding of the importance of honoring and respecting names and gender identities with a specific focus on why this matters for youth. Learn to recognize and adopt behaviors that make environments more welcoming and affirming to LGBTQ+ youth and the importance of these behaviors in preventing suicide and promoting wellbeing in young people. Participants will have time to practice using pronouns and will leave with recommendations and take-home tips.
